The Rules

General Eligibility for All Prizes

- 1. To participate in Roanoke Valley Gives day nonprofit organizations must meet the following eligibility requirements:
 - a. Eligible organizations are defined as any organization qualified by the IRS as a 501(c)(3).
 - b. Government agencies are not eligible to participate.
 - c. Organizations must be located and serving in one of the following areas: cities of Roanoke and Salem, counties of Botetourt, Craig, Franklin, and Roanoke.
 - d. Organizations must be registered on the Roanoke Valley Gives website by February1, 2017.
- 2. To qualify for any prize or incentive funds of any kind nonprofit organization must:
 - a. Must have an approved and completed Roanoke Valley Gives day profile by March
 1, 2017. Each participating organization's profile page must include the following information by 4:00 p.m. on March 1, 2017:
 - i. Your organization's logo (known as a medium avatar in the system)
 - ii. A summary and description of your organization's purpose and programs
 - iii. And updated donation box (the default language included in the Click & Pledge template "donate for" must be eliminated or updated with relevant information).
 - iv. Your organization can not be listed in more than THREE search categories (i.e. Animals, Community Development & Civic Affairs, Education)
 - v. Your Click & Pledge account must be set to the appropriate time zone (Eastern Standard Time, EST)

General Rules & Information

- 3. Roanoke Valley Gives day begins on March 15, 2017 at 12:00AM and ends at 11:59 PM on March 15, 2017.
- 4. Gifts received prior to March 15, 2017 at 12:00 AM will not be counted toward the day's totals in terms of prize calculations; unless the gift(s) are "scheduled" gifts to be posted through your organization's profile page at https://rvgives.givebig.org on March 15, 2017.

- 5. All Roanoke Valley Gives donations must be made online through the Roanoke Valley Gives website (https://rvgives.givebig.org) by credit or debit card ONLY. (Visa, MasterCard, Discover or American Express.)
- 6. Donors who enter their own credit or debit card information directly on the Roanoke Valley Gives website are entering his/her data into a secure web portal provided by Click & Pledge. Sponsors of Roanoke Valley Gives assume no liability for credit/debit card information or related information provided by the donor to a third party (e.g. organization staff member or volunteer).
- 7. Donors are encouraged to make gifts to multiple organizations of their choice. Each unique gift to a different organization will be counted on the "Most dollars raised" leaderboard.
- 8. Each gift is tax deductible and irrevocable. All donations will be for unrestricted use by the chosen charitiesunless otherwise specified on the participating organization's profile page.
- 9. All donations (not including incentive prizes/grants) are typically paid to the chosen charity within 2 business days after the conclusion of the event by TransFirst. Each organization will then receive a statement from TransFirst at the beginning of the following month indicating the organization's credit card fees and processing fees which will be debited from the organization's TransFirst account on the 10th of the following month. It is important that all nonprofits maintain an appropriate balance in its respective TransFirst account to cover the organization's credit card fees and processing fees.
- 10. A minimum donation of \$10 is required. There is no maximum per donation, nor maximum per charity.
- 11. Organizations cannot donate to themselves.
- 12. Donations may not be used to pay for anything that might be perceived as a material benefit to the donor including memberships, admission tickets, payments for tuition, payments for event tickets, etc.
- 13. Foundation for Roanoke Valley's Administrative Fund is not eligible to receive a giving day grant or prize.
- 14. One organization can win grants from multiple leaderboards.
- 15. Donors who opt to make a donation anonymously **will not** be eligible for Golden Ticket Prizes because we will be unable to announce a winner should they be chosen.
- 16. Prizes that are periodically announced throughout the day are final only after verification by Foundation for Roanoke Valley.
- 17. Some prizes are calculated by counting the number of unique donors to an organization. A unique or distinct donor is defined as a single individual or entity that made his/her donation online via the rvgives.givebig.org website and is identified via a unique email

- address. For purposes of awarding prizes, multiple donations from unique email to the same nonprofit will count as one gift.
- 18. Golden Tickets are limited to one per donor.
- 19. Power Hour prizes are awarded to the nonprofit that receives the most donations or most unique donors during a specified time period. Power Hour prizes are limited to one per organization.
- 20. Incentive funds are exclusive to qualifying nonprofits. Foundation for Roanoke Valley reserves the right to verify qualifying information and revoke, change or award prizes at its discretion.
- 21. All time-specific prizes are calculated using time-stamped data via Click & Pledge and verified by the Foundation.
- 22. In the event of a tie for an incentive prize, the prize amount will be split evenly among the organizations that tie.
- 23. Incentive pool prizes/grants will be distributed via check to the winning organizationsthe week of April 17, 2017.
- 24. As with all grants awarded by Foundation for Roanoke Valley, giving day grants are awarded at the discretion of Foundation for Roanoke Valley's Board of Directors. The Board may withhold funds if it believes a participating organization violated the mission, values and guidelines of Foundation for Roanoke Valley and Roanoke Valley Gives.

First Place: \$10,000 prize to the nonprofit with the most dollars raised

Second Place: \$5,000 prize to the nonprofit with the second most dollars raised

Third Place: \$2,500 prize for the nonprofit with the third most dollars raised

Most Unique Donors

Donations reflected in this leaderboard include the total number of unique donors that have made his/her donation via an organization's Roanoke Valley Gives day campaign beginning on March 15, 2017 at 12:00AM and ending at 11:59 PM on March 15, 2017. Eligible donations MUST be made via rygives.givebig.org.

A unique or distinct donor is defined as a single individual or entity that made his/her donation online via the rvgives.givebig.org website and is identified via a unique email address. For purposes of awarding prizes, multiple donations from one unique email to the same nonprofit will count as one gift.

- Not exceed \$800,000 in total expenses based on the organizational budget submitted to the Foundation for consideration.
- Add a special "keyword" to its respective Roanoke Valley Gives profile page. Foundation staff will notify eligible organizations by January 6, 2017, and will provide further instructions.

Donations reflected in this leaderboard include all donations received by eligible organizations via an organization's Roanoke Valley Gives day campaign beginning on March 15, 2017 at 12:00AM and ending at 11:59 PM on March 15, 2017. Eligible donations MUST be made via rvgives.givebig.org.

Power Hours

Power Hours reward the nonprofit with the most unique donors or the nonprofit that receives the most donations in any given hour. For selected hours, the nonprofit with the most donors or the nonprofit that receives the most donations will be awarded \$1,000. A unique or distinct donor is defined as a single individual or entity that made his/her donation online via the rvgives.givebig.org website and is identified via a unique email address. For purposes of

- Post your organization's video on Facebook with Foundation for Roanoke Valley tagged in the post AND include the hashtag #rvgvideochallenge17 between March 8, 2017 and March 15, 2017. You can certainly share your organization's video on your website, other social media outlets and email.
